#### THE FOREIGN INVESTMENT REGULATIONS 2006

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foreign Investment Regulations 2006, and shall come into operation on the commencement of the Foreign Investment Act 2005

Citation and commencement

2. A reference to a form by number is a reference to a form so numbered set out in Schedule 1.

# PART 2 MATTERS RELATING TO REGISTRATION OF INVESTMENT ACTIVITIES

3. The following information shall be recorded in the Register in respect of each investment activity registered in the Register -

Information to be recorded in Register

- (a) a description of the investment activity;
- (b) the name of the foreign investor conducting the investment activity;
- (c) the business name (if any) under which the foreign investor conducts or will conduct the investment activity;
- (d) the address of each premises where the foreign investor conducts or will conduct the investment activity;
- (e) the date the Registrar registers the investment activity and the reference number of the certificate of registration issued in respect of the investment activity;

- the details of any amendments to the certificate of registra--(f) tion and the date of the amendments;
- (g) whether the certificate of registration is cancelled and the date of the cancellation; and
- the surrender of the certificate of registration (if any) and (h) the date the certificate is surrendered.
- 4. At the end of each month, the Registrar must, in writing, notify the Registrar Minister of each investment activity registered in the Registrar during the month.

#### PART 3 **FORMS**

5. An annual survey under section 7 of the Act shall be in accordance with Form 1.

Form of annual survey

6. An application under section 15 of the Act for a certificate of registration shall be in accordance with Form 2 and shall set out the matters specified in section 16(2) of the Act.

Application for certificate of registration

7. A certificate of registration shall be in accordance with Form 3 and shall set out the matters specified in section 21(2) of the Act.

Form of certificate of registration

8. A foreign investor shall notify the Registrar of a change in a detail referred to in section 22(3) of the Act in accordance with Form 4.

9. An application for review under section 27 of the Act shall be in accordance with Form 5.

#### PART 4 INVESTMENT FACILITATION COMMITTEE

- 10. (1) The members of the committee are -
  - (a) the Minister for Commerce, Industries and Employment;

Membership of committee

- (b) the Minister for Finance and Treasury;
- (c) the Governor of the Central Bank of Solomon Islands; and
- (d) the Permanent Secretary of the Department responsible for administering this Act.

- (2) The Minister for Commerce, Industries and Employment is the Chairman of the committee.
- The Permanent Secretary of the Department responsible for (3) administering this Act shall be the Secretary of the committee.
- A foreign investor who holds a certificate of registration may, Application to 11. (1) after 60 days after receiving the certificate of registration, apply to the committee for assistance that will facilitate conducting his investment in Solomon Islands to which the certificate of registration relates.

- (a) be in a written form approved by the committee; and

- (a) consider the application;
- (b) determine whether to assist the foreign investor; and
- (c) if it determines to assist the foreign investor-
  - (i) determine which action specified in the regulation it shall take to assist the foreign investor; and
  - (ii) arrange for the assistance to be given to the foreign investor
- (2) The Committee shall notify the foreign investor of its decision in writing.
- 13. The committee may take any of the following actions to assist a foreign investor who has made an application under regulation 11 -

Manner in which committee may assist foreign

- make inquiries as to the status of any foreign government (a) process relating to the conduct of the foreign investor's investment;
- (b) liaise with a government department, agency or officer to resolve issues or disputes relating to conducting the investment;
- make recommendations regarding the manner in which to (c) undertake and complete procedures and processes on which conducting the investment requires.
- 14. The committee shall -

Procedures committee

- (a) determines its own procedures; and
- (b) keep a written record of all of its procedures.
